Dear Mr. Pablo de Bernardis:

The United States Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") has issued ORBCOMM a blanket license (the "Blanket License") to operate mobile Earth terminals with its Non-Voice, Non-Geostationary mobile satellite system. FCC Call Sign E940534, 10 FCC Rcd 6572 (1995). Pursuant to the Blanket License and Sections 25.115(d) and 25.135 of the FCC's Rules (47 CFR §§ 25.115(d) & 25.135), the FCC has delegated to ORBCOMM the responsibility for equipment approval ("type approval") in accordance with the FCC's Rules and policies, with respect to the mobile Earth terminals operating in conjunction with the ORBCOMM System.

Pursuant to that responsibility, ORBCOMM has analyzed the Absolut 200 with ORBCOMM OG2 Modem integrated. ORBCOMM has tested this assembly and found it to be in compliance with the applicable spectral limits imposed by the references above.
